You will notice that we try to avoid interruptions during Mass, so latecomers are expected to wait until there is a natural pause, please follows the instructions of the Welcomers. **Please avoid ALL unnecessary movement during certain parts of the Mass, especially during the Readings, the Gospel, the Homily and the Consecration, if you need to use the facilities, please return to your seat at an appropriate time without disturbing the priest or the congregation.** We love children, but you may wish to take noisy children to the Narthex or the Lady Chapel which a relatively sound proof, at least for a while.

Inform the Hospital Staff that you would like to see a CATHOLIC priest.

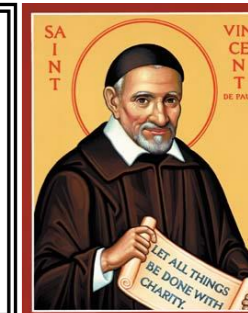
If you are sick and would like to receive Holy Communion at home, please ask. Unless we know your circumstances, we are unable to help you.
