

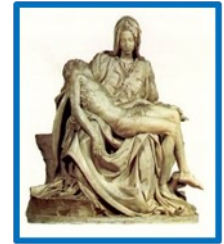

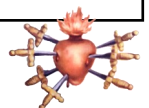

There will be a Votive Mass of Our Lady of Sorrows sung at 12 noon on Saturday 17th September, followed by refreshments so that you can get to meet all the members of the Norbertine Community. Please put the date in your diary and invite people to come along, especially those who have not been at Mass for a while. Invite them home to meet the new priests and brothers! At a later date, Archbishop John Wilson will be here to install Fr Stephen and Fr Pius as parish clergy. We will let you know that date as soon as it is arranged.

### ITEMS BELONGING TO PARISH GROUPS

As the Norbertine community has arrived, we will be moving our furniture from Chelmsford to Peckham over the next few weeks, and we will begin to repurpose and reimagine the use of some of the rooms in the Priory House with a view to renovation and redecoration. The Guild Room, for example, is to become a House Chapel eventually, so alternative locations will be found for meetings.
